

## 15 degree of Sagittarius: 'The groundhog looking for its shadow'

Various ancient folk legends ascribe to different creatures (groundhogs, badgers, squirrels, bears) the magical power of predicting when the cold weather will end and spring begin. The American version of this strange folk tale features the groundhog emerging from its barrow in early February.
