



9 degree of Aquarius: 'A flag turned into an eagle'

This is a double of the [Sabian for Sagittarius' 12th degree: 'A flag that turns into an eagle that crows'](#), the only difference the ending line which is here missing.

Without the cry of victory or the call to action the crowing symbolizes, here we are left with the knowledge that a true symbol has wings and a soul. A true symbol is the flexible outline of an archetype, the ideal form ready to receive whichever contents we need to pour into it. So this flag is turning into an eagle. Is this the idea of a fatherland (the flag) transformed into a king of birds, soaring high above all obstacles and too mighty to fear possible enemies? Or is this a flag symbolizing freedom, rebellion, defiance?

Which flag you have in mind? In all cases, if you believe in the ideal behind it, this symbol has the power to be transformed into a living, breathing reality.
